As well as our range of hire only canoes, rafts, bikes and camping equipment we offer a full instruction/guiding service that allows you to sit back and enjoy the activity along with the participants. Select from our list and design your own programme or ask us to design a custom-made programme taking into account your needs. What ever way you look at it, it's now a whole lot easier to get the very best from your stay at Dwellingup.

While most activities are located around the Dwellingup area many are portable. If you are camping at another location, we can still assist with many activities. Activity costs should be seen as a guide only. Please contact **Dwellingup Adventures** for a quote on all activity and hire equipment requirements.

Some activities that require specialist facilities are based at Nanga Bush Camp. Many of the site's facilities can be used if available, by groups not staying at Nanga Bush Camp.

All activities are based on a group size of about 20. Activity times can be structured to meet your timetable. The cost can be calculated by adding the cost of any hire equipment to instructor costs. Some activities have individual costs. Most activities will require only one instructor however you should discuss your needs in regard to water based activities with **Dwellingup Adventures** before hand.

All activity quotes include GST. Extended days may incur extra instructor fees.

Instruction/guide cost: Full day \$640.00, ½ day \$480.00.

Note: Fees apply for any canoe, raft or bikes that need to be delivered to site.
Extra travel fees may apply to activities depending on location

EXPEDITION BASED MULTI ACTIVITY/MULTI LOCATION PROGRAMMES

The most challenging and potentially most rewarding outdoor experience. Students are responsible for erecting shelter and their own cooking. Each day provides a new mode of transport or a new activity. Programmes designed and quoted in consultation with client needs

ABSEILING

Set in Nanga Bush Camp among the tall Jarrah the 18-metre tower provides participants with a challenging climb and a chance to be among the treetops. Participants are shown and demonstrate safety procedures, quality of equipment, and competency of instructors. The emphasis is on trust and the correct functioning of motor skills under stress.

The 18-metre platform is restricted for year 9 and above while the 10-metre platform is available for younger participants. The wall climb is often incorporated in the session depending on your time frame and group size. Two instructors.

For something a little different ask about the Starlight Night Abseil.

Dwellingup Adventures run abseiling activities at sites outside of Nanga Bush Camp, ask about details. Nanga Bush Camp only.

WALL CLIMBING

Set in Nanga Bush Camp among the tall Jarrah the 18-metre wall climb provides participants with a challenging climb and a chance to be among the treetops. Participants are shown and demonstrate safety procedures, quality of equipment, and competency of instructors. The emphasis is on trust and the correct functioning of motor skills under stress.

The 18-metre climb is restricted for year 9 and above while the 10-metre height is available for younger participants. The abseiling is often incorporated in the session depending on your time frame and group size. Two instructors. For something a little different ask about the Starlight Night Climbing

JARRAH ZIP LINE

The 100-metre-long flying fox line starts from an elevated platform before participant's wizz along under the tree canopy through the forest. Participants are shown and demonstrate safety procedures, quality of equipment, and competency of instructor's. A client adult supervisor is required to disconnect participants for the line at the exit.

One instructor. Note a weight restriction of 100kg applies.

REVERSE RAIN

Water goes up? It does if it's transferred to a bucket in the trees by students hoisting another up a rope swing.

Participants take it in turns to be hoisted up into the trees carrying a cup of water that the team one at a time transfers from the ground. Students are fully harnessed. Instructor acts as safety brake.

CANOEING

The Murray River provides many kilometres of navigable water for short introductory experiences or extended canoe trips. Participants are introduced to basic water safety, personal safety equipment and the basics of paddling a Canadian canoe. Experienced river guides/instructors available if required.

Canoe hire per day, \$35.00 per 2 person, \$40.00 per 3 person, (school, youth group rate only) plus instruction/guide costs if required. Water sport helmets \$2.00 each if required.

Canoe hire only option available. Canoes complete with paddles and PFDs. Trailer hire charge and delivery cost may apply.

FAST WATER RAFTING

The Murray River provides short sections that make an ideal introduction to white water rafting with some grade 1 and 2 rapids. Participants are introduced to basic water safety, personal safety equipment and the basics of paddling a two-person raft (seasonal)

Raft hire \$28.00 per day (school/youth group only) plus instruction/guide costs if required Water sport helmets \$2.00 each if required.

Raft hire only option available. Rafts complete with paddles and PFDs. Trailer hire charge and delivery cost may apply.

FLAT WATER RAFTING

Located in one of the quieter pools and in our big multi person rafts each with a guide. Participants are introduced to basic water safety, personal safety equipment and the basic teamwork required to paddle a big raft. Then a series of riotous activities and games follow. Ideal for summer months when the river is low. The stable rafts are ideal for young students, those a little nervous about water and special need students.



Raft hire only option available, **\$150.00** each raft. Each big raft takes up to 12 max junior school students Rafts complete with paddles and PFDs. Trailer hire charge and delivery cost may apply.

SWIFTWATER AWARENESS COURSES

Ideal for upper school and students studying outdoor education. The course is designed to focus on the protection of self in a swift water environment. Students are introduced to the philosophy of rescue, basic hydrology, equipment selection and use, on site safety orientation, aggressive and defensive swimming, eddy hopping, throw bags, shallow water crossings and more. One and two-day courses available. Rescue scenarios and working in a team environment included in two-day courses.

Students receive Certificate of Achievement on completion.

DISCOVER DWELLINGUP BY BIKE

A self guided tour of local points of interest. Visit the Dwellingup History and Visitor Information Centre, Hotham Valley Railway, Forest Heritage Centre, POW Camp or maybe ride the Marrinup Forest Tour and picnic along the way. Bikes collected from and returned to our town office. Helmets and water bottle cages supplied with each bike.

Bike hire \$27.00 per bike if using a Dwellingup Adventures instructor. Bike hire \$30.00 per day if hiring bikes only (school/youth group only). Helmets, water bottle cage with each bike.

Please note Dwellingup Adventures does not have bikes or run bike activities for year 6 or the equivalent age group and below.

MOUNTAIN BIKING FOR BEGINNERS

After a bike introduction, bike fit, safety and skills session Dwellingup Adventures instructors lead a local exploratory ride. Dwellingup Adventures staff select a suitable route in and around Nanga Bush Camp and Lane Pool reserve based on activity time frame and age. Parts of the Munda Biddi Trail can be ridden depending on group requirements.

Bike hire \$27.00 per bike if using a Dwellingup Adventures instructor. Bike hire \$30.00 per day if hiring bikes only (school/youth group only). Helmets, water bottle cage with each bike.

Please note Dwellingup Adventures does not have bikes or run bike activities for year 6 or the equivalent age group and below.

BUSH CRAFT 'KULLARI THE GECKO'

On an imaginary hunt students see the bush as a friend rather than something to be feared or conquered. Featuring the many and varied traditional uses of the local flora and fauna and information on the hunter gatherer lifestyle of the first inhabitants.

LOW ROPES ACTIVITIES 'JARRAH JUNGLE GYM'

A series of swinging, climbing, hoisting and balancing activities designed to burn up some energy and have heaps of fun doing it too. The focus is on support and trust with the core elements of the teamwork model examined

Instructor cost plus ropes course hire or set up fee. Depends on location.

POSERS & PREDICAMENTS

A series of problem-solving activities and a chance to look at the teamwork model in depth. We demonstrate by practical application effective communication, strategies and planning and leadership models.

YOU WIN I WIN GAMES

A series of non-competitive cooperative activities where everybody wins. An informal introduction to team-work and common goals.

ADVANCED BUSH CRAFT

Innovative practical lessons on all of the camp craft skills required to live in safety and comfort in the bush. First aid, camp cooking, navigation, water procurement, equipment and minimal impact camping.

TUCKER UNDER THE TREES

Suitable for the none fire ban months' students learn fire and campsite etiquette, and safety. Each student makes their own small damper and cooks it on the open fire adding jam or honey for a tasty snack. Hot milo is provided. Instructor cost plus **\$1.10** catering charge for each student

EVENING ACTIVITY 'WHEEL OF MISFORTUNE'

A team game show based on the TV game format. A light-hearted look at pickles, plights and predicaments all with an outdoor flavour. Activity complete with game compare and wheel. Caters for numbers from 10 to 100.

\$170.00 per session, about 1½ hours

EVENING ACTIVITY 'NIGHT ENCOUNTERS'

The changing mood of the forest as night descends. Increased dependence on non-visual senses. Featuring a journey through the heavens using the stars as guides. (weather permitting)

\$170.00 per walk about 1½ hours

EVENING ACTIVITY TALL TALES AND GHOSTLY CHARADES

Who is behind the ghostly mask? Each student gets to hide their identity while others guess who they are. Spine tinkling tales are told to finish off the evening if time permits

\$170.00 per session, about 1 ½ hours

DIY (DO IT YOURSELF) ACTIVITIES

Dwellingup Adventures introduce a number of activities with a DIY option. You can still use a **Dwellingup Adventures** staff however you have the option of running the activity yourself. Each activity includes all material, activity explanation, delivery and collection from site

DIY activities are \$140.00 per day or \$110.00 per half day.

No additional material hire charges if **Dwellingup Adventures** run activity

Some DIY activities may not be available depending on your camping location

ORIENTEERING/QUEST 'GUIDE ME HOME' (DIY or Dwellingup Adventures Staff)

Participants follow the trail using a map and compass. The task is to locate all the lost animals and stamp them on your landscape in their preferred home environment. Maps, compasses, stamps, clues, landscape all provided. Suitable for lower school. **An activity set up cost of \$45.00 is applicable.**

LOST ON MT NANGA (DIY or Dwellingup Adventures Staff)

Students read they have crash landed on Mt Nanga but fortunately find an old jelly bean miner's camp. They need to construct a shelter. Poles, ropes, star pickets, hammer and covers provided

RAFT RESCUE (DIY or Dwellingup Adventures Staff)

Students are supplied with barrels, poles, tubes, ropes and paddles. They must construct a raft and 'rescue' a stranded mariner. 12 buoyancy vests are supplied Extra buoyancy vests available at **\$4.00** each if required



COMPASS WHEEL (DIY or Dwellingup Adventures Staff)

Students commence at the wheel's hub; a bearing takes them to a lettered post. Another bearing takes them to another until each bearing has a letter. The wheel is about 15 metres across and 6 courses are available. **An activity set up cost of \$45.00 is applicable.**

ROGAINING (DIY or Dwellingup Adventures Staff)

Students locate each station using a map and compass and punch the score card. A short course suitable for about 2 hours and a longer 3-hour course are available. Variations include scoring points for various stations located and setting time limits. Activity includes facilitator instructions, compasses, and maps. The stations are set by **Dwellingup Adventures** each with a flag and a punch. **An activity set up cost of \$45.00 is applicable. Two way radios available for hire.**

PIPEOMETER (DIY or Dwellingup Adventures Staff)

Students must assemble the pipe structure and then fill it with water and release the ping pong ball noting that some of the pipes have holes that need to be covered. The activity set includes facilitator notes, pipeometer plans, pipes, buckets and measuring tapes

EVENING ACTIVITY GIANT GAMES (DIY or Dwellingup Adventures Staff)

A series of rotating activities where each team completes a number of simple skill activities with a giant theme. Points are awarded as each team moves around the game circuit. The activity set includes facilitator notes and four giant games.
