

Munda Biddi Explorers CUSTOMER DETAILED INFORMATION

This is a self-guided/supported tour. No guides accompany you however we assist you in delivery to start points.

Booking is essential.

Day Structure Dawn Creek Road to Dwellingup

Please arrive at Dwellingup Adventures Tour Desk Waypoints Café situated in the Dwellingup Trails and Visitor Centre at 8.30am for both the day tours. Customer toilet facilities are available at the centre as are hot showers, laundromat, and locker storage.

When you arrive at Dwellingup we complete the paperwork for the mountain bike hire and you pay. We issue your cycle helmet if you do not have your own, maps and track notes.

We will run you out to the Junction of Nanga Road and Dawn Creek Road. The start is a pleasant 5km gentle downhill run to pick up the Munda Biddi Trail and visit Bidjar Ngoulin Hut

Total distance from the start including a visit to Bidjar Ngoulin is about, 35km.

Arrive back in Dwellingup before 5pm.

Day Structure Whitakers Mill to Dwellingup

Please arrive at Dwellingup Adventures Tour Desk Waypoints Café situated in the Dwellingup Trails and Visitor Centre at 8.30am for both the day tours. Customer toilet facilities are available at the centre as are hot showers, laundromat, and locker storage.

When you arrive at Dwellingup we complete the paperwork for the mountain bike hire and you pay. We issue your cycle helmet if you do not have your own, maps and track notes.

We will run you out to the Junction of Whitakers Mill and the Munda Biddi Trail. The route from Whittaker's Mill (Whittaker Road Scarp Road Junction) to Dwellingup via the Munda Biddi trail is 39kms. Riders wishing a shorter distance can be dropped at the track crossing on Del Park Road. The distance back to Dwellingup from here is 25kms. The longer 39km ride may make optional loops around Turner Hill and/or Marrinup Circuit subject to timing and fitness. Loops of 1 or both circuits on the shorter route may be less problematic.

Arrive back in Dwellingup before 5pm.

Day Structure Over Night Tour Lake Brockman to Dwellingup

Please arrive at Dwellingup Adventures Tour Desk Waypoints Café situated in the Dwellingup Trails and Visitor Centre at 8.30am for both the day tours. Customer toilet facilities are available at the centre as are hot showers, laundromat, and locker storage.

When you arrive at Dwellingup we complete the paperwork for the mountain bike hire and you pay. For the overnight tour your bike will be prepared with its rear panniers and dry carry bag. We issue your cycle helmet if you do not have your own, maps and track notes.

See lightweight camping gear for hire if required.

If you are doing the overnight tour your preparation may be a little longer with packing and adjusting loads and bikes. Once completed we will run you to the start point at lake Brockman Dam and Munda Biddi Trail Junction. Your day 1 ride takes you to Bidjar Ngoulin Hutt, about 43km. Day 2 sees you continuing the Munda Biddi into Dwellingup, 30kms. Arrive back in Dwellingup before 5pm.

We Supply

Giant or Specialized 24 speed mountain bikes complete with front suspension, disc brakes and water bottle cages. Water bottles are not supplied. Each party is supplied with a basic tool kit along with spare tubes. Bikes for the overnight tour are supplied with rear left and right waterproof panniers and a dry carry bag.

Vehicle Security

Dwellingup does not have a high crime rate but you park your vehicle at your own risk on the street in front of our office. Dwellingup Adventures accepts no responsibility for vehicles.

What To Bring

Comfortable bike riding wear is required. Closed in footwear is recommended. A small day pack should be carried for the day tour with some rain wear, your lunch items and personal items.

Track Conditions

The Munda Biddi Long Distance Mountain Bike Trail is generally suitable in all weather conditions. In wet weather some sections can be a little slippery and in long periods of dry weather some sections can be soft. While most of the track travels through forest lined trails and thus is shaded sections can get very warm in summer.

Maps

A colour copy of the Munda Biddi map of the riding section is included in the hire. It is best however to provide your own genuine map should you wish to mark or retain it for your own interest. Munda Biddi Maps are at our onsite shop or available at most good camping outlets or online at <https://shop.dbca.wa.gov.au/>

Safety

Mobile reception is unreliable although you may get pockets of reception depending on your phone and provider.

If you require an emergency phone, there are two land lines in the park.

Entry Ranger Station: if occupied rangers have a phone.

Nanga Bush Camp: a phone box close to the manager's residence is available for emergency and local calls only at no cost. Both locations are on your map.

Dwellingup Adventures is not a medical emergency response agency, and all emergency calls should be made to 000.

As best note or describe your location. Emergency services will typically try to get to you. Dwellingup Adventures may be able to assist emergency staff so call 95381127.

For a non-medical emergency call Dwellingup Adventures for assistance.

Serious Mechanical or Damage Fault

The mountain bikes are serviced and supplied in good order. However, the track is rough in parts and riding the Munda Biddi is not the same as ducking to the local shop on your pushbike. Ride carefully for your own safety and be conscious that you will have extra weight and the bikes performance characteristics will have changed. Ride slowly downhill always under control. If in doubt walk the bike. Change gears gently and 'feel' the mechanics of the bike change. You will be some distance from assistance. If you have a fall and if the bike is damaged and unridable 'we have a problem Houston'

You should try to contact Dwellingup Adventures and we will assist.

Waypoints Picnic Package.

Ask about our optional Picnic Package from \$15.00 per person. Include fresh wrap or sandwich, cookie or raw slice and a freshly squeeze juice. Please check about multi meal packages.
