



# **Walkers Weekends Detailed Customer Information**

## Friday Day 1

Please arrive at Dwellingup Adventure Tour Desk situated at Waypoints Cafe in the Dwellingup Trails and Visitor Centre on Friday from 2-4pm for key collection or arrive at Waypoints **Saturday Day 2** from 8am.

Customer toilet facilities are available at the centre as are hot showers, laundromat, and locker storage.

Please note late arrivals **Friday Day 1** can be made up to 8pm by prior arrangement only. Receive house and bedroom keys, Waypoint's Café voucher for weekend, maps and walk descriptions/track notes, emergency procedures. Please note map details are coloured laminated and cover your walking area only. Full Bibbulmun Track map number 2 North Bannister to Harvey Quindanning Road is avail for purchase from our Trails Shop.

Optional recommended walkers register. In the case of you requiring assistance this will assist with emergency personal. We also ask you to check in at Waypoints on your return for both walks.

## Saturday Day 2

Our charter bus will collect you from Waypoints Café at 10am Saturday morning. Here we take your walking party into the Lane Poole Reserve and drop you on River Road your access point to Swamp Oak Hut. From here you follow the Bibbulmun Track at own leisure and pace back to Dwellingup. Distance 13.1kms. Please check into Waypoints Café and tick your walkers register. Once back in Dwellingup enjoy an evening meal at the Dwellingup Hotel. (please book prior the hotel gets bus). or use full kitchen facilities at the Dwellingup Holiday House.

## **Sunday Day 3**

Our charter bus will collect you from Waypoints Café at 10am Sunday morning. Here we take your walking party to Inglehope Road to follow the Bibbulmun Track back to Dwellingup. Please check into Waypoints Café and tick your walkers register.

Special walkers weekend check out late 4pm Sunday plenty of time to complete walk, freshen up and enjoy afternoon tea and coffee at Waypoints Café. Please return house and bedroom keys to Waypoints Café.

- Dwellingup Holiday House is a 2-storey residence with large bathroom with bath and shower and second toilet downstairs. There is a spacious kitchen. With all utensils and cooking equipment. Please label own food if using shared fridge.

### **Suggested Wear and Preparation for Daytime Walks:**

You should have a comfortable daypack. Shoulder sling bags and school back packs are unsuitable. You will need to comfortably carry your day pack all day. Food to own requirements. Small first aid kit and personal items. Carry 3 to 4Ltrs water. There is no water en-route. Be conscious of weather, ypur clothing choice should reflect this. Dwellingup can get very cold and wet. A raincoat should always be carried. Comfortable, covered walking shoes. Light weight and comfortable walking shorts and shirt. Remember in winter when you break you can get cool, so often a light jumper can keep you warm. ### Safety Plan:

Whilst the Bibbulmun Track is marked it is not impossible to get lost. You will get footprints of mobile reception depending on service provider. Your map and walk notes are quite detailed, and frequent referral to map and track notes should enable a pleasant and safe walk. Dwellingup Adventures is not an emergency response organisation. Should you have a life-threatening emergency contact 000 or 112 if you do not have reception. Dwellingup Adventures may be able to assist for minor injuries that impede your walking.

#### **Bibbulmun Track Membership Discount:**

Bibbulmun Track members receive a 10% discount on equipment hire and tours including Walkers Weekends. Booking must be under a Bibbulmun Track members name and they must make payment, no split payments.

#### **House Facilities:**

Heating: There is a slow combustion stove downstairs for cooler months. Wood is supplied.

When lit the heat travels up the stairwell and comfortably warms the bedroom

areas.

Cooling: Each of the bedrooms has a reverse cycle air conditioning unit. The downstairs

area remains cool and comfortable. Some electric fans are available for very warm

days.

Bedrooms: Bedroom 1 has a gueen bed with built in robe. Bedroom 2 has double bed with

walk in robe and Bedroom 3 has 2 singles beds and a built-in robe. Beds have

donnas with all bedroom linen supplied.

Stairs: The house is 2 stories. Child gates are positioned at the top and bottom of the

stairs.

Bathroom: The large bathroom contains an enclosed combination bath shower with toilet. All

bathroom linen is supplied.

Kitchen: Electric stove, microwave, fridge, sandwich maker, toaster, kettle. There is a range

of utensils, crockery, cutlery, pots, stove ware, glass ware, tea towels and

dishwashing products to suit 6 persons. All kitchen linen is supplied.

Laundry: Washing machine and outside fold away line is provided. Pegs and laundry

powder are provided. There is a downstairs separate toilet in laundry area.

Living Areas: Satellite, TV, DVD and CD player in lounge area with comfortable lounges. The

dining area has a 6-seater setting. There is a 3-seater by 2-seater sofa in family area. Board games and range of toys plus grassed area games are supplied. A smaller entertainment unit is located in dining area with iPod docking function.

Outdoor Area: A 6-seater outdoor setting with a gas BBQ is located under a covered patio area.

A small, grassed area alongside is suitable for children playing on. The property is fully fenced with well-maintained gardens There is an undercover car port with a

wide verge suitable for extra parking.

Pets, Smoking: This is a non-smoking house and pets are not permitted.
